The annual conference takes place this year at Crewe + Alsager College of Higher Education. The venue is the Alsager site of the College, situated in rural Cheshire but with easy access to the M6 and to Crewe and Stoke-on-Trent railway stations.

There are only 240 places, allocated on a 'first come first served' basis, so early return of application form and deposit is advised. The deposit is £12 for BERA members and £17 for non-members (which includes part of their higher conference fee). The total cost of the conference will be about £40 for the three days for residents; for non-residents, it will be £20. The deposit will be returned if you apply after the 240 places are all taken.

After receipt of the deposit and booking form, a final booking form and a conference programme (including abstracts of papers) will be sent to you.
