# CALL FOR PAPERS

### General Information

Proposals for papers, symposia and other presentations will be considered for inclusion in the programme *if they are received before 30 April 1989*.

Papers are presented in the formats set out in the BERA conference guidelines. In addition other types of sessions may be considered if members wish to suggest different formats. Only papers that have not been published or presented to other conferences are eligible.

Presenters of papers must supply the following with their proposals:

- a) Two copies of a summary of their paper typed double spaced on 2 to 3 pages of A4 paper.
- b) Two stamped, self-addressed envelopes for acknowledgement of the paper and notification of the conference committee's decision.
- c) Two 3 x 5 in. index cards typed in the following format:  
Name of presenting author (Last name first)  
Complete mailing address including postcode  
Telephone number including STD code  
Title of presentation.

NB Since the conference takes place at the end of the summer vacation you should give an address that will reach you during the period immediately before the conference in addition to any other address you might give.

d) Organisers of symposia are responsible for the organisation of their sessions but should accept the same procedures as outlined in a) to c) in collaboration with the conference committee. Proposals for symposia must be made to the conference committee in the same way as set out above but in addition the names of symposiasts and an indication of the time requested must be supplied.

*Proposals for all types of session must provide clear specifications for any type of AVA equipment they need.*
