Brief notes of guidance for Symposium Organisers

Symposia involve several contributors. They can take a variety of forms including presentations, discussions, or workshops.

Each symposium normally has a three-hour programme slot allocated by the Conference Committee.

As a symposium convenor it will be up to you to recruit and brief contributors, and to provide the Conference Committee with an outline of the symposium and abstracts of the contributions.

All offers of symposia from BERA members are usually accepted, and offers from non-members are also welcome. If more than one offer is received for the same topic, the different groups will be put in touch with each other.

We shall be especially interested in symposium contributions from researchers from other countries, and will try to help get funds to support travel. (However, note the point about expenses below.)

A fuller set of guidelines will be sent to anyone who submits a proposal for a symposium.

Brief notes of guidance for Individual Contributors

Individual papers are grouped on the Programme into broad areas of interest. Each paper is normally allocated half an hour.

Contributions are of various kinds. Some report research findings, others offer critical comment on findings or raise issues in methodology.

Presentations can take a variety of forms, including discussions or workshops. The full half-hour should not however be spent on presenting the paper: time should be left for discussion.

A fuller set of guidelines will be sent to anyone who submits a proposal for a paper.

Please note that BERA cannot pay fees or expenses to symposium organisers or individual contributors, who must meet the cost of attendance at the Conference from their own sources.
